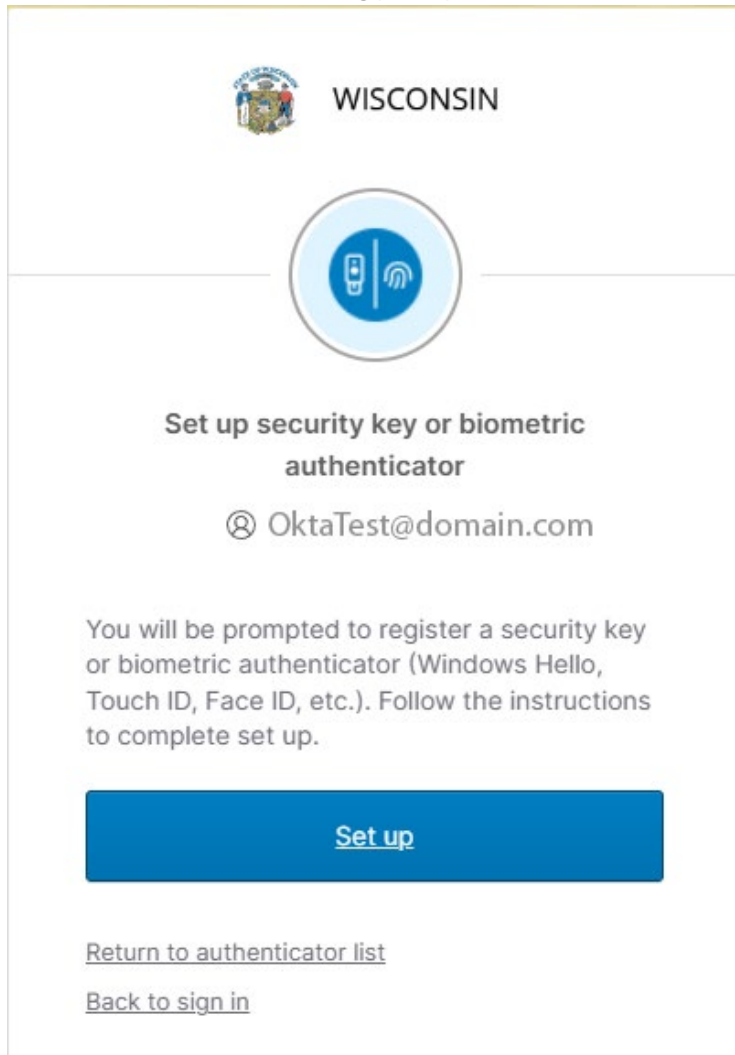

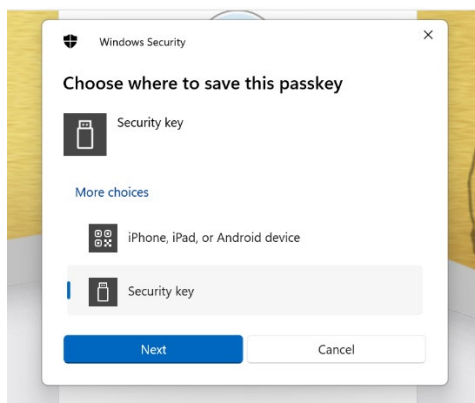

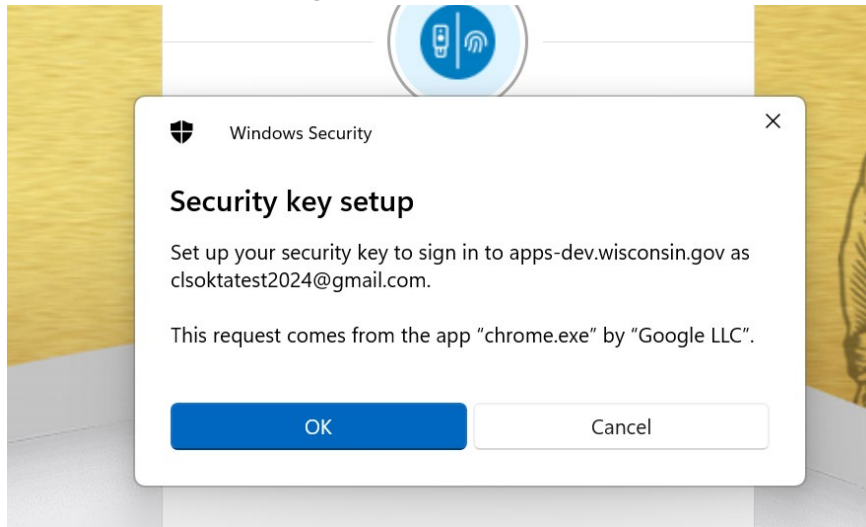


Click **Set Up**



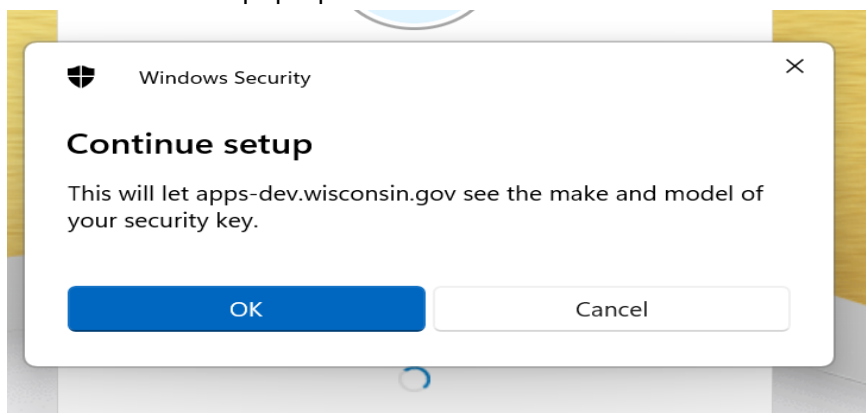
To continue with YubiKey or FIDO2 configuration, click **Security Key** and then **NEXT**

You will see a new pop-up:

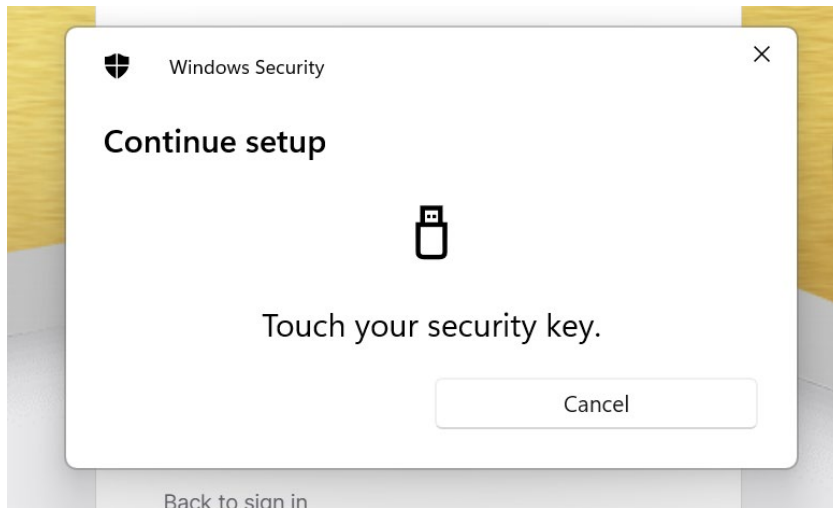


Click **OK** to continue.

If this is the first time using your YubiKey or FIDO2 authenticator, you will need to push the copper looking piece with an Y in it.

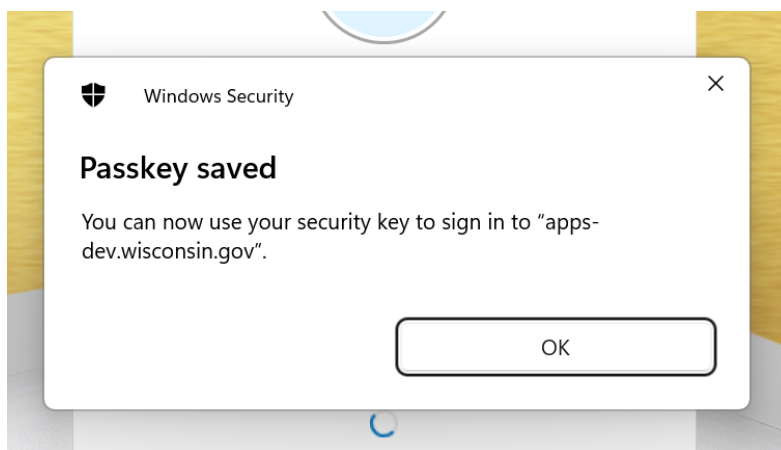


You will then be prompted to touch your security key as follows:



Touching your Security Key will close the prompt and submit the authorization for logging in to your MyWisconsin ID account.

Your Passkey is now Saved:



Click **OK** to continue!

You will not be logged into your MyWisconsin ID account (and/or your application).

Next time you Log in you will be challenged for Password and MFA – you push your copper Y and you will be logged into MyWisconsin ID account or your application.
