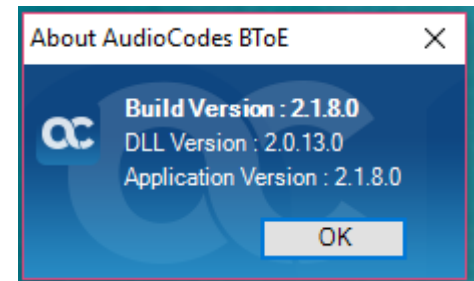


## BToE on PC's for enhanced S4b with phone devices

*Updated instruction for Windows 10.*

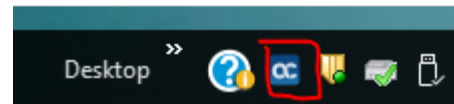
The BToE app eliminates the need for the user to login directly to the phone. It should be installed on every user's PC. When the user logs into their PC, the BToE app will prompt the user for their Skype4B credentials and send it to the phone to login. The phone will keep the credentials until the Password changes. So the user will only need to do this once every 60 days.



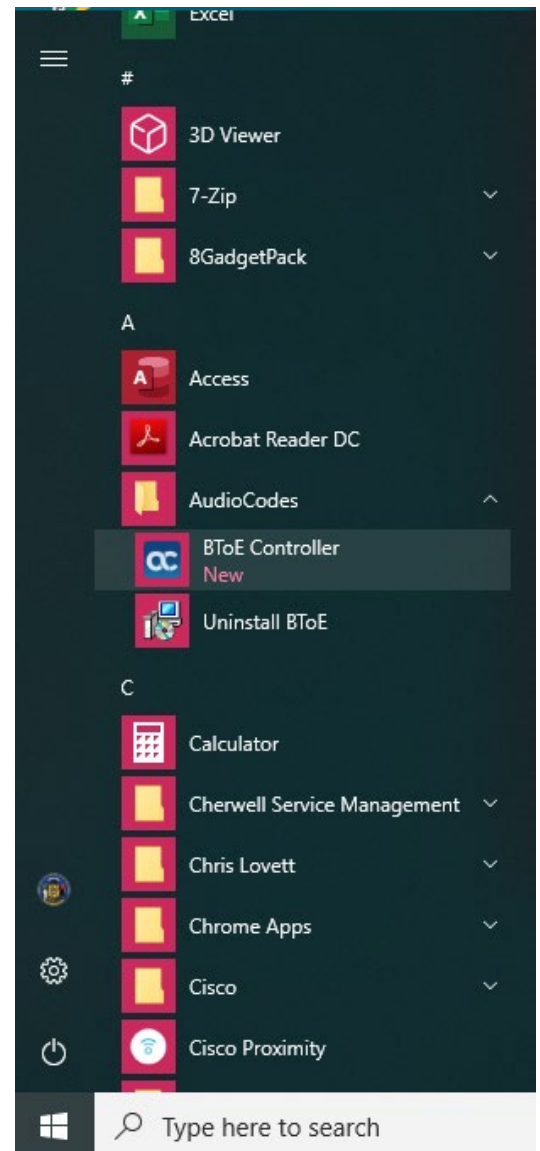
The BToE app does not initially start by itself. You need to start the app and then set the parameter to "Start with Windows".

First make sure that the Skype for Business Client is running and the user is logged in.

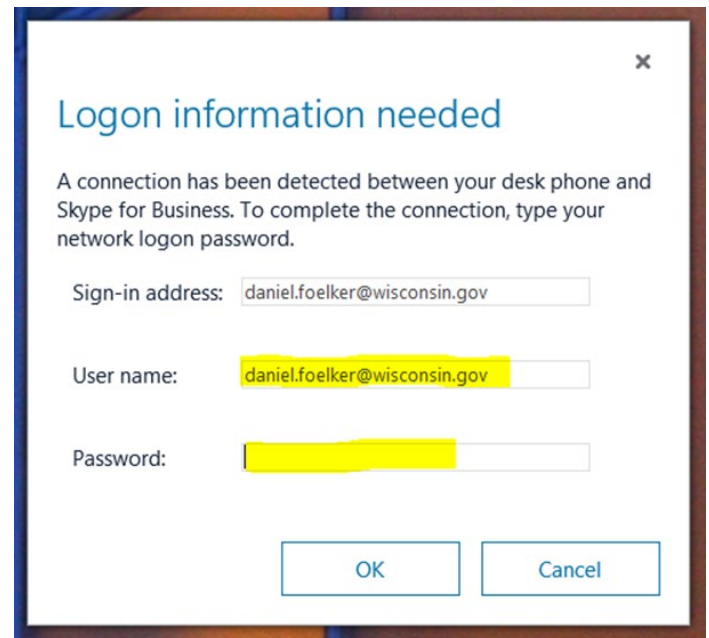
Confirm that the BToE app is running. If it is running, you will see a small "ac" icon in the system tray (lower Right):



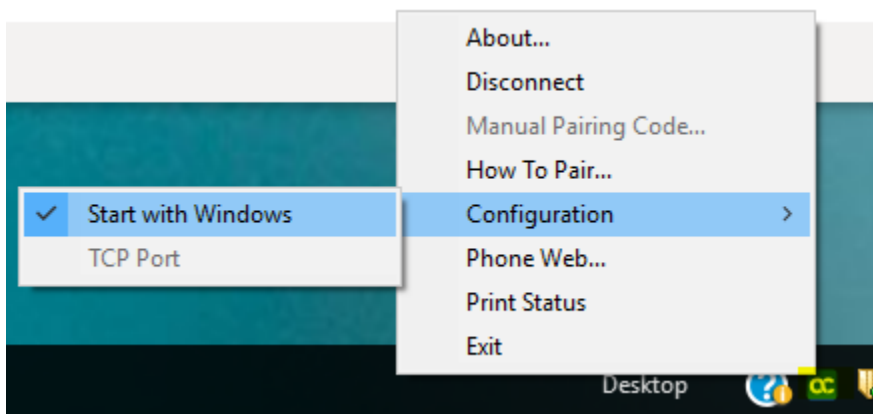
If it is not running, click on the Windows icon (lower Left) and look for an AudioCodes folder in your list of programs. Open and click on the BToE Controller app. The BToE app will start.



If the phone is connected, a window should appear asking for Logon Information. Please note that the Sign-in address and User name should both be the user's Email address. Enter the Password and click OK.



To ensure that the BToE app starts every time the PC restarts, right click on the "ac" icon in the system tray and go to configuration. Make sure that the "Start with Windows" option is checked:



When this setting is set, it only applies to the user currently logged in. If someone else logs into the PC (i.e. assigned to a new user), the setting does not carry over and will need to be set again.
